CONTACT LENS PROFESSIONAL FEES AND WARRANTIES

Contact lens fees are based on the level of complexity of the contact lenses and the amount of time required to obtain the correct vision and best comfort. The doctor will discuss the best plan for your specific needs.

Level 1 (SPHERICAL)

(Standard spherical contact lenses)

Includes initial tear and cornea evaluation, evaluation of contact lens function and follow-up visits for up to 30 days from the initial visit

Level 2 (TORIC)

(Astigmatism contact lenses)

Includes initial tear and cornea evaluation, evaluation of contact lens function and follow-up visits for up to 60 days from the initial visit.

\$120

LEVEL 3 (CUSTOM TORIC/RGP/SCLERAL)

Includes initial tear and cornea evaluation, evaluation of contact lens function and follow-up visits for up to 90 days from the initial visit.

\$165

LEVEL 4 (BIFOCAL/HYBRID/CUSTOM LENSES)

Includes initial tear and cornea evaluation, evaluation of contact lens function and follow-up visits for up to 120 days from the initial visit.

WARRANTY AND EXCHANGE POLICY

1. In order to finalize your contact lens Rx, you ***must*** return for the follow up appointments.
2. If we do not hear from you within 30 days of the trial lens dispense date and your insurance is on hold for contacts, we will file with your vision plan for our services (exam and fitting).
3. Multipack lenses may be exchanged for product of equal value for 6 months after the date of the dispense *if* the boxes are unopened and are at least 24 months from the expiration date listed on the box.
4. If lenses are returned for credit and were covered by your insurance, we will refund the insurance company and ask them to reinstate your benefits.
5. **Tinted contact lenses CANNOT be returned or exchanged.**
6. Vial lenses may be returned within 60 days if they are defective or the doctor changes the Rx.
7. Rigid gas permeable lenses have a 30 day warranty against defects.
